The Nonprofit Leadership Certificate is designed for professionals looking to enhance their leadership skills in the nonprofit industry at any level. Faculty encourage reflective practice and focus on leading organizational change. Numerous electives allow you to tailor the coursework to fit your experiences and interests.
